 - 1. Hook and Loop 1" and 2" FR Nylon, Black
 - a. Meet requirements of A-A-55126, Fastener Tapes, Hook and Pile, Synthetic
- C. Llovet Sales Co., Inc.
 - 1. Buttons, Melamine
 - a. Industrial strength and heat resistant
- D. Saunders Thread, Co. (UL Recognized, QGVD2.MH14954)
 - 1. Thread Spun Kevlar, Tex 70, Natural

II. Construction

- A. Manufactured in the U.S.A.
- B. All stitching is a minimum of 6 ½ stitches per inch
- C. Major seam allowance of minimum ¾" and minor seam allowance of minimum ¼"
- D. All seams double stitched
- E. Shoulders, sleeves, collars, pockets and all other flaps double top stitched
- F. Pockets, pocket flaps, collar and collar flap bar tacked

III. Design

- A. All measurements are in accordance with the minimum sizing requirements of NFPA 1977 Standard on Protective Clothing and Equipment for Wildland Fire Fighting 2005 Edition
 - 1. Full cut to allow freedom of movement in all aspects
 - 2. Available in sizes XS – XXXXXL.
- B. All design requirements comply with NFPA 1977 Standard on Protective Clothing and Equipment for Wildland Fire Fighting 2005 Edition
 - 1. Button front closure
 - 2. Collar remains upright after extension into a vertical position with hook and loop storm flap closure
 - 3. Sleeve cuffs have closure system with adjustable hook and loop, providing a snug fit around the wrist while wearing gloves
 - 4. All exterior pockets have button closure flaps
- C. Optional features
 - 1. Double sleeves available upon request

6. Cleaning precautions
7. Following statement is printed on label:
"DO NOT REMOVE THIS LABEL"
